- ***Do you own a shotgun?*** If so, this may make your home an attractive target for criminals. Always ensure that your shotguns and ammunition are stored securely, keys located away from the cabinet itself, and their location kept discreet.



Transport your firearms securely

The Firearms Security Handbook defines the minimum standards for protecting firearms in transit, but further measures should be considered where practicable, for example by securing them to the vehicle chassis or separating integral parts such as the fore-end or stock from the rest of the firearm.

A firearm left in an unattended vehicle is vulnerable to theft. If you do need to leave your vehicle then you may wish to consider removing and carrying integral components on your person to render the gun unusable in the event of theft.
